GENERAL INFORMATION SECTION

1. EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE.

Emergency numbers are listed on the front cover of this directory; however, emergency assistance can be obtained by dialing the base operator. Emergency calls are placed ahead of other calls and are monitored by the base operator.

2. COMMANDER'S HOTLINE.

Action Line is a direct link between the 20th Fighter Wing Commander and Shaw AFB personnel. Questions or problems that cannot be resolved through normal channels can be called in at 895-4611 where they will be recorded for research by the office of primary concern. Caller should leave a name and telephone number in case questions need to be clarified. Names will be kept confidential and used only to provide callers with a personal response. Comments of general interest will be published in the SPIRIT newspaper.

3. INSTALLATION TELEPHONE SYSTEM.

Telephone communications for Shaw Air Force Base are provided by the 20th Communications Squadron. The 20th CS accomplishes this task through two civilian contracts. DESA Inc. provides switchboard service under one contract, and UKPIK LLC provides telephone equipment service under the other contract.

a. To obtain the most efficient and effective telephone service, users of the system should be thoroughly familiar with the instructions contained in this directory. In addition to following the instructions, the following four suggestions are offered. First, wait for a dial tone, dial your number carefully, identify yourself, speak clearly, and make the conversation brief. Second, answer the phone promptly. Identify the office reached and person speaking. Third, use the telephone directory-Don't guess at numbers. Finally, don't leave the receiver off the hook or set the hold button to prevent completion of incoming calls.

b. Military telephones are authorized for government official calls only. Their use is restricted to calls essential to the accomplishment of the mission. Personal calls are considered unauthorized and come under the preview of Fraud, Waste, and Abuse. Unauthorized calls that obligate the United States Government for payment are subject to prosecution under provisions of applicable laws and regulations. Such calls are fully investigated by

the government. Unofficial and personal calls should be placed using coin operated pay telephones.

4. TELEPHONE CLASSIFICATIONS.

There are three telephone classifications used at Shaw AFB that restrict calls to various degrees.

a. Class A telephones allow direct-dial access to base extensions, local commercial numbers, and the Defense Switching Network (DSN). These phones provide 1-800 direct dialing and access to commercial operators for placed credit card, third party billing, and collect calls.

b. Class B telephones allow direct-dial access to base extensions and local commercial numbers. These phones do not provide access to DSN or a commercial operator.

c. Class C telephones allow direct-dial access to base extensions only. All incoming long distance to class C telephones are intercepted at the base switchboard in order to deny acceptance of collect call toll charges. This class of telephone is widely used in base dormitories.

5. ON BASE CALLS.

Calls made to other base extensions can be dialed directly using by dialing the seven digit numbers.

6. LOCAL AREA CALLS.

Calls made to local commercial numbers can be dialed directly from class A and B phones by dialing 99 + seven digit local number. The following exchanges are in the local dialing area: Sumter 773, 775, 778, 418, 436, 840, and 890; Stateburg 494, and 501; Shaw AFB Heights 666; Pocalla 481, and 506; Pinewood 452; Oakland 499; North Sumter 469, 491, and 905; East Sumter 495; and Mayesville 453. Toll free numbers can be dialed directly from base phones by dialing 99 + 1+ 800 or 99 + 1 +888 and seven the digit number.

7. FEDERAL TELEPHONE SYSTEM (FTS) CALLS.

Official FTS calls can be placed by dialing 99 + 1 + Area Code + seven digit number. The 1 + area code must always be dialed even if calling within South Carolina.

8. INTERNATIONAL LONG DISTANCE/TOLL CALLS.

Calls going outside of the United States that will incur a toll charge to Shaw AFB. Official International long

distance calls should only be placed when other means of communications will not suffice. Other means of communications include letters, e-mail, and DSN off-netting.

a. To place a long distance call, dial 0 and give all information requested by the operator. A telephone control number is required for all calls that will incur a toll charge. Control numbers can be obtained from your unit Telephone Control Officer (TCO).

b. Credit card, third number billing, and collect calls can be dialed by dialing 99 + 0 Area Code (even calling outside South Carolina) 99 + 0 + seven digit number.

c. There is a charged incurred for verification and interrupt service: therefore, a control number is required for this service.

9. DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE.

Always consult the base telephone directory first. Personal listings are not included in this directory. For duty numbers of military members, call the base locator at extension 895-2811. For duty numbers of civilian employees, call civilian personnel at extension 895-1617. Directory assistance numbers are as follows:

- a. Shaw AFB. (On Base Directory Assistance Dial 113)
- b. Off Base Directory Assistance Dial 895-1110
- c. Sumter Local Directory; Refer to Base Operators for Office Use Only.
- d. Long distance. Dial 0 and give the base operator the area code and the number, these calls will also consist of having a control number.

(GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL ONLY).

- e. DSN INFORMATION. Dial 94 + 231-1211.

10. OPERATOR ASSISTANCE.

Shaw AFB operator assistance can be reached by dialing 0. The following assistance is provided:

- a. Emergency assistance.
- b. Commercial long distance call/FTS service.
- c. Local number dialing assistance.
- d. Conference calls.
- e. DSN precedence calls.

- f. Dialing procedures/information.

11. SPECIAL TELEPHONE FEATURES.

The base phone system provides the following standard features.

a. Switch hook Flash. To request a feature while engaged in a conversation, you must have a distinctive dial one. You may obtain this tone by "Flashing" the switch hook. Flash means to depress and release the switch hook momentarily (about one second).

b. Call Hold. To place call on hold: Flash the switchhook (you get a unique tone) Dial the Call Hold feature code #71 and hang up.

To retrieve a held call: Pick up the handset Dial the Call Hold feature code #71, you will be reconnected to the call.

NOTE: If, when placing caller on hold, hang up, the system will reconnect you to your caller by ringing you back.

c. Transfer. While on an active call, Flash the switchhook (you get a unique tone). Dial the seven (7) digit number the call is to be transferred. Upon hearing the ring back the transferring station can either: Hang-up to complete the transfer, or wait for an answer, and flash the switchhook once to establish a three-way conference. *In case of busy, no answer or misdial, Flash to return to the original party.

- d. Three Party Conference.

See call transfer (information same as above)

In case of busy, no answer or misdial when attempting a conference to station, Flash to return the original party.

e. Call Forward. Allows temporary forwarding of your incoming calls to another station or local outside number: Pick up the handset. Dial feature code desired:

*70-Call Forward All Calls

*93-Call Forward Busy

*94-Call Forward Don't Answer

Dial the seven (7) digit number you wish to forward your calls to. Hang up when you hear a confirmation

tone.

Remove Call Forward: Pick up the handset. Dial feature code desired:

#70-Call Forward All Calls-Cancel

#93-Call Forward Busy-Cancel

#94-Call Forward Don't Answer-Cancel

Hang up when you hear a confirmation tone.

f. Ring Again. After encountering a busy signal: Flash the switchhook (you get a unique tone). Dial the Ring Again feature code-*87. Hang up after hearing a confirmation tone.

When the busy station becomes idle, you will receive special ringing. When you lift the handset, the system will automatically dial the station.

To cancel Ring Again feature, lift the handset and dial the feature code-#8

g. Call Park/Call Park Retrieve.

To park at call, dial the Call Park feature code *85

To retrieve the parked call from a different telephone: Pick up the handset. Dial the Call Park Retrieve feature code #85.

Dial the number against which the call is parked.

h. Call Pick-Up

Pick up the handset. Dial the Call Pick-Up feature code *75, you are connected to the call.

i. Last Number Redial.

Pick up the handset. Press the number sign (#) key twice. The last number you dialed will be automatically dialed by the system.

12. CARE OF TELEPHONE EQUIPMENT.

Telephone users are responsible for the proper use, case, and safekeeping of the telephone equipment and instruments, and are liable for any loss or damage thereto. Under no circumstances will the user move, alter, or make additions to the equipment. Telephone equipment that is found to have been tampered with by unauthorized personnel will be disconnected and withdrawn from the using agency.

13. BURIED TELEPHONE CABLES.

A permit is required from base civil engineering prior to excavating, grading, ditching, and driving stakes or poles. This permit must be coordinated with the 20th CS/SCX at phone number 895-5678 or extension 119 before breaking ground. These instructions apply to all military agencies and civilian contractors working on Shaw AFB.

14. REQUESTING, RELOCATING, OR TERMINATING TELEPHONE SERVICE.

Submit requests to 20 CS/SCX, 895-5678.

15. TELEPHONE TROUBLE REPORTING.

If you need repair service dial extension 119 Monday through Friday from 0730 to 1630. After normal duty hours or from non base numbers call 895-2666.

16. TELEPHONE SERVICE COMPLAINTS.

Our goal at 20th CS is to provide you with excellent quality service. If, for any reason, you are not satisfied with any aspect of our service, please call the appropriate quality assurance evaluator.

a. For complaints concerning telephone equipment service, call 20th CS/SCOIT at 895-5666.

b. For complaints concerning telephone switchboard service, call 20th CS/SCOIT at 895-5666.

17. NUISANCE AND BOMB THREAT CALLS.

Any person who uses indecent language, threatens unlawful acts or makes false statements concerning death or injury to the family of the person called; who telephones others repeatedly for purposes of annoyance, who fails to hang up for the purpose of interfering with the telephone service of another or who permits any telephone under his or her control to be used for such unlawful purposes shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable as prescribed by law.

a. Nuisance and bomb threats can be traced. To initiate a trace:

- Call is received

- Flash

- Listen for distinctive dial tone

- Dial 101 you will be automatically reconnected with the caller.

b. In case of a bomb threat call, try to get as much of the information listed on AF Form 440 as possible. AF Form 440, Bomb Threat Aid, should be located under every telephone.

c. DO NOT HANG UP THE PHONE. Call extension 895-3700 from another phone to locate where the call originated.

d. Bomb threats or other threatening calls should be immediately reported to security policy at extension 895-3669.

18. MINIMIZE.

Minimize is a condition that necessitates controlling normal e-mail and telephone traffic to avoid delaying communications directly related to an actual or simulated emergency. It is imposed by the commander, or higher authority, of the emergency are to eliminate non-essential traffic. Communications to the affected area should be "MINIMIZE CONSIDERED" meaning the communications is essential traffic.

19. FAX SERVICE.

Reserved.

20. TELEPHONE DIRECTORIES.

This phone directory is only as accurate as the information provided by the individual unit of Shaw AFB. Unit TCOs should submit telephone number additional, changes, and deletions by letter to 20th CS Base Telephone Switchboard Project Manager so that the directory can be kept current. In addition, phone listings will be requested from unit TCOs prior to publishing a new directory in order to verify the accuracy of the current listings.

a. Office symbols must be in accordance with AFR 10-6, Air Force Standard Functional Address System and Regulation, and AFR 340-4 Office Management.

b. Abbreviations must be in accordance with AFR 11-2, Air Force Abbreviations.

21. DEFENSE SWITCH NETWORK (DSN).

DSN is the Defense Communications System (DCS) command and the control information transfer network.

a. In addition to providing familiar voice telecommunications service for command and control elements, and for those engaged in logistics, personnel, engineering and other activities that support command and control elements world-wide, DSN will provide data and video services reflecting the technological changes of the information age.

b. The DSN is designed as a primary system of communication during peace time, periods of crisis, pre-attack, theater non-nuclear, and post attack phases of war.

22. DSN PRECEDENCE SYSTEM.

Calls of a given precedence will not normally preempt calls of an equal precedence; however, calls originated by the President of the United States, Secretary of Defense, Joint Chiefs of Staff, and CINCs can preempt any call in progress by applications of their FLASH OVERRIDE capability.

a. FLASH. FLASH calls preempt IMMEDIATE, PRIORITY, and ROUTINE calls and will be handled as fast as system capabilities allow. Listed below are examples of FLASH calls.

- 1) Calls pertaining to command and control of military forces essential to defense and retaliation.
- 2) Critical intelligence essential to national survival.
- 3) Conduct of diplomatic negotiations critical to ceasing or limiting hostilities.
- 4) Dissemination of critical civil alert information essential to national survival.
- 5) Continuity of federal government functions essential to national survival.
- 6) Fulfillment of critical United States internal security functions essential to national survival.
- 7) Catastrophic events of national or international significance.

b. IMMEDIATE. IMMEDIATE calls preempt PRIORITY and ROUTINE calls and are reserved for communications pertaining to situations, which gravely affect the security of national and allied forces. These calls will be handled as fast as possible. Listed below are examples of IMMEDIATE calls.

- 1) Reconstitution of forces in a post attack period.
- 2) Intelligence essential to national security.
- 3) Conduct of diplomatic negotiations to reduce or limit the threat of war.
- 4) Implementation of federal government actions essential to national survival.
- 5) Situations that gravely affect the internal security of the United States.
- 6) Civil defense actions concerning direction of the populations and their survival.
- 7) Disaster or events serious enough to have an immediate and detrimental effect on the welfare of the population.
- 8) Vital information having an immediate effect on aircraft, spacecraft, or missile operations.
- 9) Distress assistance.

c. **PRIORITY.** PRIORITY calls preempt ROUTINE calls and are reserved for communication requiring expeditious action by called parties furnishing essential information for conducting government operations.

d. **ROUTINE.** This precedence applies to official government communications, which require rapid transmission by telephonic means, but do not require preferential handing. A ROUTINE call does not preempt any other call and is handled sequentially as placed by the calling party.

23. PLACING DSN CALLS.

The DSN provides global telephone service for authorized users. Some users can call everywhere while others are limited to one particular area or combination of areas. Where you can call depends on your mission and whether your telephone line is equipped accordingly. Refer to the Defense Switched Network Telephone Directory for more information.

Inter-Area calling (ROUTINE).

- lift receiver, get dial tone
- dial 94
- listen for the DSN dial tone
- dial the DSN number

For calls out of your dialing area or higher precedence calls, dial 0.

a. Calls to commercial numbers. Official long distance calls may be placed using a combination of DSN and local base switchboard lines. When authorized by the local commander, base switchboard operators may connect incoming DSN calls to a commercial number if the called commercial number is within the toll-free radius of the switchboard.

b. Conference calls.

- lift receiver, get dial tone

- dial 94

- listen for DSN dial tone

- dial 231-1211

- advise the DSN operator of the conference call request

(1) Credit card and collect calls may be dialed from a class "A" telephone by dialing "99" + "1" + the toll-free number.

24. FREQUENTLY CALLED DSN NUMBERS.

The following listing includes most Air Force activities and frequently called installations. Certain installations have direct in-dialing which means if the desired extension at the destination is known, the number can be dialed directly using the prefix given in the listing. Prefixes are followed by an "X" for each digit required for the extension.
